Fifteen participants embarked on their very first poultry farming journey, and a remarkable transformation followed—over two-thirds took a bold step of faith, reinvesting their own funds and successfully doubling their initial poultry stock. A true testament to mindset shift, confidence, and entrepreneurial growth!

Transforming Lives in the East Region Through Faith and Enterpreneurship

The East Team carries a deep passion for spreading the Gospel of Jesus Christ and igniting holistic transformation. Confronted with immense challenges—high illiteracy rates, extreme poverty, cultural complexities, and occult influences—they recognized that true change required more than just awareness; it needed action. With a vision to break cycles of poverty and dependency, the team saw entrepreneurship training as a key solution. By equipping individuals with practical skills, they are shifting mindsets from "My grandfather is bewitching me, so I cannot prosper" to "Through knowledge, resilience, and hard work, I can create my own success."

Leading by example, the team built sustainable initiatives—a piggery farm, cassava cultivation, and a nursery & primary school that started in a home and, through prayer and hard work, now has a dedicated building. Their transformed lives are a testimony to the community, proving that God's power, combined with perseverance, can change destinies.

Today, inspired by these tangible transformations, the community is responding. Seeing what God has done, they are stepping forward, embracing change, and becoming agents of transformation in their own lives. The journey continues, and the impact grows—one life, one skill, one step of faith at a time.

Breaking Barriers and Transforming Mindsets



FAR NORTH (MORA)

Mora, with its rich cultural heritage and diverse ethnic groups such as the Mafa, Mandara, and others, has long been shaped by traditional beliefs and practices. While farming, livestock rearing, and trade remain central to their way of life, certain mindsets—such as not engaging in lucrative projects or seeing education as unnecessary—have contributed to a low rate of children completing primary school.

Recognizing this challenge, MEPCAM stepped in with entrepreneurship training and livestock support, particularly through the distribution of goats. This initiative is not just about providing resources but about reshaping perspectives and unlocking new opportunities.

Participant Testament

Hayava Joshua, one of the program's participants, shared: "Even my neighbors have become jealous of me because of how well my goats are doing."

While his success is evident, we challenged him to think beyond personal achievement—to turn this opportunity into a sustainable income stream, ensuring that his children stay in school and inspiring others in his community to do the same.

This is just the beginning. Transforming minds takes time, but step by step, we are breaking generational barriers, fostering self-reliance, and creating a future where education and entrepreneurship go hand in hand

Functional Livestock Model Farm

In 2024, MEPCAM took a bold step toward sustainability by launching the Model Farm, a hub for practical entrepreneurship training with a focus on livestock farming. Beginning with the rearing of day-old chicks, the journey has been filled with both challenges and triumphs.

Despite starting without a qualified livestock expert, MEPCAM demonstrated resilience and adaptability, bridging the gap by hiring a veterinary doctor who provides periodic guidance based on the birds' growth cycle. Through learning, persistence, and innovation, we have seen remarkable progress—and not a single season of loss!

This initiative is already transforming lives:

Empowering young graduates – One university graduate on a stipend took his entrepreneurship training to heart, using the farm premises not only to maintain the space but also to launch his own tomato farm, creating a path to self-sufficiency.

Supporting TL 5 participants – The farm plays a crucial role in equipping TL 5 Project participants, providing starter feed to help them kickstart their own poultry ventures.

Enhancing MEPCAM's training programs – With hands-on experience in livestock farming, the MEPCAM team now delivers more practical and impactful training, bringing real-life expertise to aspiring entrepreneurs.

This is just the beginning! The Model Farm stands as a symbol of growth, sustainability, and opportunity, paving the way for greater impact and a brighter future. Together, we are building something that lasts!
